Statement of the measures in place regarding Covid-19

The statement of measures regarding Covid-19 supplements the existing [Data Protection Statement](#) dated November 2018 and our general [Terms & Conditions](#).

The hotel has developed a comprehensive Health & Safety concept adhering to government regulations issued by the Bundesamt für Gesundheit (BAG) as well as the regulations and guidelines of the Swiss hotel industry (Hoteleriesuisse). These guidelines have been specifically adapted for Badrutt's Palace Hotel. Experts have externally audited the Health & Safety concept entitled "Clean & Safe".

All our staff have been thoroughly trained in our Health & Safety concept before the doors of the hotel opened and we can guarantee that these measures and how we put them into practice are continually being reviewed for their validity and effectiveness and updated if necessary.

1. Additional data collection and processing

In order to protect you, our guests, and our staff as best as possible from being infected with Covid-19, we are required to gather the following data from you:

- Body temperature readings on entering the hotel by means of an infrared camera.
- Only those readings indicating an increased body temperature will be held for a maximum of 14 days.
- A manual temperature reading will then be undertaken in the case of a reading showing heightened body temperature.

2. Precautionary Measures

Please be aware that the following measures apply in cases of temperature readings indicating a fever or heightened body temperature, or in the case of showing other typical symptoms (such as a dry cough, aching muscles, loss of taste and smell - this list is by no means exhaustive):

- Until further medical advice has been sought, it is requested not to remain in the public areas of the hotel.
- We explicitly recommend that you seek medical help by calling a doctor.

3. Liability of the Hotel

- Due to the hotel having a comprehensive and certified Health & Safety concept in place, the hotel cannot be claimed to be liable or undertake any costs incurred in the event of a guest becoming ill.
