1896	Official opening of Palace Hotel on 29 July.	2018	Swiss hotelier Richard Leuenberger becomes Managing Director of Badrutt's Palace Hotel.
1898	Caspar's son Hans Badrutt (1876–1953) takes over managing the hotel.	2018	Relaunch of King's Club for the winter season 2018/19 with a new Dining & Dancing concept together with British star chef Jason Atherton, street artists Bane & Pestand international DJs such as Joe T Vannelli, Tom Novy or the Studio 54 legend Kenny Carpenter.

1969–70	Expansion of the hotel with a spa complex.	2022	Renovations on the 2 and 5 floors, as well as for the staff restaurant Bella Vista were completed by the winter season 2022/2023.
1981–84	The Suot Mulin complex is built housing rental apartments and suites.	2022	Start of hotel expansion with 25 suites by Italian architect Antonio Citterio.
1999–03	Hansjürg Badrutt and his wife Anikó retain luxury hotel chain Rosewood Hotels & Resorts, USA, to manage Badrutt's Palace Hotel.	2023–24	Pop-up restaurant Jordnaer from Copenhagen enchants guests.
April 2003	Badrutt's Palace Hotel is successfully managed again as a private hotel.	2024	Opening of the new outdoor pool.
2002	Opening of the luxury shopping mile Serletta, the so-called Palace Galerie, over 2000 m ² directly opposite Badrutt's Palace Hotel.	2024	Chef Daniel Rose gave a pop up guest performance over the Christmas holidays
2004	Swiss hotel manager Hans Wiedemann becomes Managing Director of Badrutt's Palace Hotel.	2025	Opening of the new Serlas Wing, designed by Italian star architect ACPV Antonio Citterio Patricia Viel Architects
